Venue of the tournament: Jurmala, Latvia

The tournament will take place in the luxurious Semarah hotel Lielupe

2. Date and location

International Open Children and Youth Chess Tournament RUDAGA – KAISSA 2019 will be held with the support of Jurmala City Council and Semarah hotel Lielupe in Jurmala, Latvia from 22th to 26st of August. On the arrival day a sightseeing tour of Jurmala and its surroundings can be orginized on request.

The tournament will be held in the Semarah hotel Lielupe (Jurmala, Latvia, bulduru pr/64/68).

1st round – 24th of August: Opening ceremony and beginning of the tournament at 12.30 (Orginizers have a right to change the start time of the tournament).

2nd round – 25st of August: tournament, concert for the participants and award ceremony.

3. Organizers and Support

4. Rules and Regulations of the Tournament

- 1. The participation in the tournament is open to the A, B and C Class players as well as the novice with no rank, who are not older than 18 years at the time of registration;
- 2. The tournament will be played on the Swiss system (7 games)
- 3. Each participant will be given 30 minutes to end of the game (Clock will be used after the given time)
- 5. The tournament is to be played according to the rules of FIDE with the addition of the Chess sport rules and the use of computerized draw swissmanager.
- 6. Winners will be determined by the highest number of points obtained in all the games.

All participants must be insured at the time of travel and stay in Latvia. Teams must have the appropriate number of accompanying persons, guaranteeing the safety of participants.

The costs for awarding the winners, technical personnel, local and non-residential judges, rental of venue and transport as well as manufacturing of printed and promotional materials, awarding

diplomas and prizes are to be covered by the tournament organizers.
