




REGULATION

FIDE ENDORSED INTERNATIONAL CHILDREN
AND YOUTH CHESS FESTIVAL

“RUDAGA – KAISSA 2021”
23RD JULY – 1ST AUGUST 2021





1. GOALS AND TASKS

- Popularization of chess among children and youth.
- Professional development of youth national teams and other participants, incl. ELO rating calculated and titles granted.
- Increasing the level of sportsmanship and qualifications of the participants, including the calculation of the international FIDE rating and gaining FIDE titles.
- Development of the intellectual human *capital* of the younger generation.
- Strengthening of regional and international sports cooperation.

2. TIME AND VENUE

The FIDE Endorsed International Children and Youth Chess Festival «Rudaga-Kaissa 2021» will be held from 23 July to 1 August 2021 in Jūrmala, Latvia.

Venue: Jurmala, Latvia, « Semarah Hotel Lielupe », Bulduru pr. 64/68 Lielupe Hall.

3. ORGANIZERS

The International Chess Federation (FIDE) endorsed International Children and Youth Chess Festival “Rudaga - Kaissa 2021” is organized by the non-governmental organization "Rudaga Plus" and supported by FIDE, Latvian Chess Federation, Jurmala City Council, Children and Youth School of Education and Creativity “Rudaga” (Jurmala, Latvia), chess club “KAISSA” (Riga, Latvia), Semarah Hotel “Lielupe” (Jurmala, Latvia).

4.2 RAPID TOURNAMENT

Participants and groups:

- Tournament A - participants born in year 2001 and younger;
- Tournament B - participants born in year 2005 and younger;
- Tournament C - participants born in year 2009 and younger;
- Tournament D - participants born in year 2013 and younger.

The Rapid tournament is held according to the FIDE Laws of Chess, Swiss System, 7 rounds. The draw, scoring and additional indicators will be produced by the Swiss Manager Program.

Time control for each player:

10 minutes + 5 seconds per move, starting from move 1.

Groups A, B, C will be FIDE ELO rated.

Group D - will be NOT be FIDE ELO rated.

Each player (except players in group D) **must have** a FIDE ID.

The winner will be the player with the highest number of points scored. In case of a tie of two or more players, the following tie-break criteria in the order of priority will be used:

1. Reduced Buchholz without the worst result (CUT-1);
2. Buchholz;
3. The result of the direct encounter;
4. The greater numbers of wins.

In case of any dispute, the decision of the Chief Arbiter is final.

4.3 STANDARD TOURNAMENT

Participants: born in year 2001 and younger.

The Standard tournament is held according to the FIDE Laws of Chess, Swiss System, 7 rounds.

The time control for each player: 60 minutes + 30 seconds per move, starting from move 1.

The draw, scoring and additional indicators will be produced by the Swiss Manager Program.

The tournament is FIDE rated (discipline "standard").

Each player must have a FIDE ID.

The winner will be the player with the highest number of points scored. In case of a tie of two or more players, the following tie-break criteria in the order of priority will be used:

1. Reduced Buchholz without the worst result (CUT-1);
2. Buchholz;
3. The result of the direct encounter;
4. The greater numbers of wins.

In case of any dispute, the decision of the Chief Arbiter is final.

4.4 BLITZ TOURNAMENT

Participants: born in year 2001 and younger.

The Blitz tournament is held according to the FIDE chess rules, the Swiss system, 9 rounds, time control for each player: 5 minutes + 2 seconds per move, starting from move 1. The draw, scoring and additional indicators are carried out using the Swiss manager computer program.

The tournament is held with an international blitz rating calculation. Each player **must have** a FIDE ID.

The winner will be the player with the highest number of points scored. In case of a tie of two or more players, the following tie-break criteria in the order of priority will be used:

1. Reduced Buchholz without the worst result (CUT-1);
2. Buchholz;
3. The result of the direct encounter;
4. The greater numbers of wins.

In case of any dispute, the decision of the Chief Arbiter is final.

6. ENTRY FEES

The amount of registration fee for participation in tournaments:

Blitz tournament - 15 EUR

Rapid tournament - 25 EUR

Standard tournament - 35 EUR

In case of participation in the Rapid + Standard Tournament, the participant is exempted from paying the tournament fee in the Blitz Tournament.

Participation fee in a simultaneous game session - 10 EUR.

Children with special needs and orphans (upon presentation of a document) are exempt from the fee.

If a player does not participate in the tournament, fees are not refundable.

Registration and accreditation will be considered complete when the application form (questionnaire) is filled out, the tournament fee in the required amount to the current account has been received (applies to players) and once a player has received Confirmation of Accreditation from the Organizer.

Organizations or individuals of delegations must bear the costs of their arrival to the venue and back as well as accommodation and meals for the entire period of the tournament. All participants must be insured for the duration of their travel and stay in Latvia. Teams must have an appropriate number of accompanying persons to guarantee the safety of the participants.

The costs of prizes and all other organizational costs will be borne by the organizers.

7. AWARDS

7.1. Rapid Tournament

The Winner of the Rapid tournament among boys and girls in each group (A, B, C, D) will be awarded a commemorative cup. Winners of the Rapid tournament in each group (A, B, C, D) among boys and girls will be awarded with diplomas and medals for 1st, 2nd, 3rd places, as well as with memorable gifts.

7.2. Standard Tournament

The Winners of the Standard tournament among boys and girls will be awarded with cups for 1st, 2nd, 3rd places, diplomas, medals and valuable gifts.

The winner of the tournament among boys and among girls receives Accreditation for the World Chess Olympiad 2022, an entrance ticket for the Opening Ceremony and accommodation for two nights in the official hotel of the Olympiad.

Additional prizes for the tournament:

- 1st, 2nd, 3rd places among boys and among girls under 10 years old (born in year 2011 and younger);
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd places among boys and girls under 14 years of age (born in year 2007 and younger);
- special prizes from sponsors in the category "Chess style", the prizes for the youngest players, etc.

Each participant of the tournament receives a diploma of participation and a commemorative medal.

7.3. Blitz Tournament

The Winner of the Blitz tournament among boys and girls in each group will be awarded a commemorative cup. The Winners of the tournament among boys and girls will be awarded with diplomas and medals for 1st, 2nd, 3rd places, as well as memorable gifts.

8. ENTRIES

Participation in the tournament is confirmed by an invitation sent by the Organizer, based on received applications, lists of participants and payment of the registration fee. All players must be registered and accredited by the Organizer.

Registration and accreditation will be considered complete when the application form (questionnaire) is filled out, the tournament fee in the required amount to the current account has been received (applies to players) and once a player has received Confirmation of Accreditation from the Organizer.

Applications for participation are accepted **until July 20, 2021** (if you need a **visa, applications are accepted until July 10, 2021**). The organizers reserve the right to close or renew the registration. Application forms:
