1. ORGANISATION

3 main events will take place: A (elite standard); B (amateur standard); C (children standard). Additional tournaments: D (blitz) tournament and evening E (chess variants) tournaments.

Date -5-9 July, 2023.

2. FORMAT AND REGULATIONS

A, B and C tournaments will be held by FIDE standard chess laws, D tournament – by FIDE blitz chess laws. FIDE ratings will be calculated.

The winner will be the player who scores the most points. In case of a tie, places will be determined based on these tiebreakers:

- 1. Median-Buchholz coefficient (minus the worst opponent result);
- 2. Full Buchholz coefficient;
- 3. Progress coefficient;
- 4. Berger coefficient.

All chess players are invited to participate. Maximum number of participants in both A and B tournaments -120.

Chess players, whose FIDE standard chess rating is lower than 1800, A tournament Entry Fee is 100€.

7. VARIANTS

On **July 6-8**, starting at **21:30**, chess variants **E tournaments** will be held. The time control, the number of rounds and the tiebreakers will be determined based on the number of players. Expected duration of the tournaments: ~2 hours.

8. PRIZES
