ELO Tournament with GM, IM, WGM, and WIM norms

The tournament is planned to be part of the International Chess Federation (FIDE) tournament series (FIDE Circuit), the winner of which qualifies for the World Championship contenders tournament.

Regulations: Swiss system, 9 rounds, FIDE rules, ELO rated.

FMs, WFMs, juniors up to 18 years of age, and seniors over 65 years who represent the Latvian Chess Federation have a 50% discount.

Discounts do not add up. This discount does not refer to the additional charge for late registration.

Financial prizes

The prize fund of tournament A is **17 100 EUR** (guaranteed in case of at least 200 participants), and the first prize is guaranteed to be **2 500 EUR**. 25 general prizes and special prizes for the best women, junior (born 2005 and later), and senior players (born 1963 and earlier) as well as rating prizes in at least 4 groups. General prizes are shared using the Hort system, special prizes are not shared. A player can receive only one prize.

- b) Buchholz;
- c) Rating Performance.

Entries

Early registrations (by specifying your Name, ELO, Date of Birth, Country, and accommodation if necessary) for the tournaments A - D and Y should be sent before the 28^{th} of July either by e-mail: $\underline{\text{chess@rtu.lv}}$ or by filling out the $\underline{\text{APPLICATION FORM}}$.

The onsite registration according to the schedule of the corresponding tournament is mandatory also for online pre-registered participants, including participants that have free entry.

The organizers reserve the right to exclude players that have missed the onsite registration deadline from the tournament.

Players from the Russian Federation or the Republic of Belarus cannot participate in the festival, regardless of their status, including the so-called neutral athlete.

Prize giving

All players must be present at the closing ceremony to receive financial prizes. The organizers reserve the right not to pay out prizes if the participant fails to arrive.

Accommodation

Festival participants and guests are offered special prices in the official hotels of the festival. The number of rooms is limited, so reservations will be made on a first-come, first-served basis. The indicated prices are guaranteed until the numbers reserved by the organizers have run out, but no later than the **28th of July**.
