

RTU Open Dice Chess tournament

1. Aims and objectives:

To popularize the exciting game of Dice Chess for players of all ages.

2. Tournament management:

3. Tournament format:

The Dice Chess tournament follows the Swiss system with 12 rounds (6 double rounds) and a time control of 5 minutes + 5 seconds per move for each participant.

4. Venue and time:

4.1. The tournament will take place on August 9, 2023, at the international exhibition center "Ķīpsala," Ķīpsalas street 8, Riga.

- Round 6: 13:00

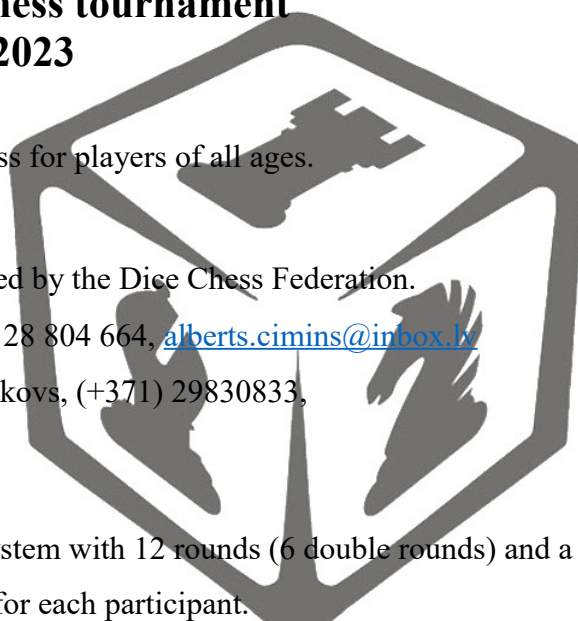
5. Participants:

All players of any age and skill level are invited to participate in the "Dice Chess" tournament.

6. Tiebreak rules:

6.1. In case of equal points, the following tiebreakers will be used:

- 6.1.1. Improved Buchholz (excluding the worst result)
- 6.1.2. Buchholz
- 6.1.3. Rating performance in the tournament (RST)



7. Prizes:

Total prize fund – 400 EUR.

1st place – 70 EUR
2nd place – 40 EUR
3rd place – 35 EUR
4th place – 30 EUR
5th place – 25 EUR
6th place – 20 EUR
7th place – 15 EUR

Women's 1st place – 40 EUR
S50 1st place – 30 EUR
U18 1st place – 30 EUR
U18 2nd place -25 EUR
U18 3rd place -20 EUR
U18 4th place -10 EUR
U18 5th place -10 EUR

The youngest boy and girl will receive special prizes. There will also be a prize for the best foreign player.

NOTE: A participant can only receive ONE prize.
