Venue and time

The open international children's and youth chess festival "Rudaga - Kaissa 2024" will be held from 14 - 19 August 2024 in Jurmala, Latvia. The venue: "Lielupe by Semarah Hotels" (conference center "Lielupe"), Bulduru prospekts 64/68, Jūrmala, LV-2010.

"A" tournament

OPEN tournament for everyone.

Playing system: Swiss system, 9 rounds, FIDE rules, FIDE rated.

Time control: 60 minutes per game for each player + 30 seconds for each move made, starting from the first.

"B" tournament

Tournament for players with the second sports class in chess.

Playing system: Swiss system, 9 rounds, FIDE rules, FIDE rated.

Time control: 60 minutes per game for each player + 30 seconds for each move made,

starting from the first.

Classic 3,4, and without sports class players with 30 min without a clock, then 5'+3" 17.08.-18.08.

"C" tournament - III sports class

Tournament for players with the third sports class in chess.

Playing system: Swiss system, 9 rounds, FIDE rules.

"D" tournament - IV sp.kl.

Tournament for players with the fourth sports class in chess.

Playing system: Swiss system, 9 rounds, FIDE rules.

Time control: no time control.

"E" tournament WITHOUT Sports class

Tournament for beginners/players without sports class in chess.

Playing system: Swiss system, 9 rounds, FIDE rules.

Time control: no time control.

"F" tournament - PRESCHOOLERS

Chess tournament for preschool children without a sports class.

Playing system: Swiss system, 9 rounds, FIDE rules.

Time control: no time control.

Blitz tournament 16.08.

Open tournament for all players without age and skill level restrictions.

Playing system: Swiss system, 9 rounds, FIDE rules, FIDE rated.

Time control: 3 minutes per game for each player + 2 seconds for each move made, starting from the first.

Rapid tournament 18.08.

Open tournament for all players without age and skill level restrictions.

Playing system: Swiss system, 8 rounds, FIDE rules, FIDE rating calculation.

Time control: 10 minutes per game for each player + 5 seconds for each move made, starting from the first.

Other terms

Places won in tournaments are determined by the number of points obtained. In case of an equal number of points, the following additional indicators are used:

- ◆ Improved Buchholz coefficient (discarding the worst result);
- ♦ Buchholz coefficient;
- ♦ Achievement of increasing coefficient (in "C", "D", "E", "F" tournaments) and ranking in the tournament (in all other tournaments).

Visa support is provided on request to all foreign chess players who have applied by 1 July 2024.

7. Additional information

The expenses for the award of winners, the remuneration of technical staff, local and foreign judges, the festival venue and the rental of vehicles, the production of printed matter and advertising materials shall be covered by competition organisers.

Competition expenses related to travel, accommodation, catering or other expenses of participants in competitions and their attendants shall be covered by participants in competitions or organisations represented by them. Foreign players must have a valid travel insurance policy for the entire planned maintenance period in the Republic of Latvia.

Each adult competitor shall be personally responsible for the conformity of his or her state of health with the competition. The parents or organisation which applies for the commencement of participants shall be responsible for the conformity of the medical condition of the minor contestants.

We would like to inform you that this festival is a public event and that its conduct may be reflected in the media, including your participation in this event. During the event, photography and filming may be carried out for the purpose of informing the public, in accordance with Article 6(1)(e) of the General data Protection Regulation. Photographs and video footage will be published on the websites of the Jurmala State City municipality, as well as the chess and sports industry, their social network accounts, as well as in the media. Tournament results will be posted on www.chess-results.com. Time limit for processing of data – permanent.

8. About Jurmala

Jurmala is the largest seaside resort town in the Baltic States, located on the coast of the Gulf of Riga and stretching along the coast for more than 20 kilometres, with 11 improved beaches. Historically, the city has brought together 12 villages – Priedaini, Lielupe, Buldurus, Amber, major, Double, New doubles, buds, Melluge, tears, Vaivars, New Kemerus and two small towns – Slok and Kemerus.

Jurmala is a true oasis of natural healing and health, boasting an almost incredible concentration of natural resources that cannot be found on any southern sea coast. It is one of the few European
