## II Time Control and Programme:

Time Control: 1h30 + 30 seconds increase per move.

#### III Teams:

Teams will be composed of 10 players, 2 per birth-year, minimum 1 girl and 1 boy per team, to be born in the following years:

2004 or later: 2 players (U20) 2006 or later: 2 players (U18) 2008 or later: 2 players (U16) 2010 or later: 2 players (U14) 2012 or later: 2 players (U12)

### IV Costs:

The foreign teams will plan, manage and pay for their own transport to the accommodation and back to their homeland (Tallinn Airport is just approximately 4 km away from the venue and hotel).

Pre bookings in IBIS Tallinn Center for each foreign team are made as follows:

 a. 7 twin rooms, breakfast included (14 separate beds) for three nights (Thursday to Sunday) at special rate of Euro 80/night/twin room. 1680 € per team.

- b. If you would require additional rooms, please let us know latest on <u>15 of September</u>. We will arrange for this, subject to availability (first come, first served).
- c. Members of ChessMates will be granted 1000 Euros sponsorship money, which will be used to pay your hotel accommodation and deducted from the hotel accommodation invoice that we will send to each foreign team. Each foreign team will have to pay such invoice before arrival at the venue.
- d. Teams that wish to stay until Monday (including Sunday night), please let us know latest on <u>15 of September</u>. We will arrange for this, subject to availability (first come, first served).

A contribution of 1200 € would be asked from each team for transport, all lunches and dinners for 12 persons (10 players + 2 coaches):

- Coffee, tea, water and cookies at the venue
- Thursday dinner at the Hotel
- Friday lunch at the venue
- Friday dinner at the Hotel
- Saturday lunch at the hotel
- Saturday Gala Dinner at the Hotel
- Bus transport between the hotel and the venue

To develop and maintain the Olympic sportsmanship, each team would be asked to share a gift on every round to their opponents (team flag, souvenir, etc.).
